



1st June - Return to school

Nursery, Reception, Y1, Y6 and Lockdown attendees.

Thank you to our whole school community for their hard work and good wishes.

We are looking forward to welcoming you back. We have been working hard to make sure that we can return safely. 😊

Please **DO NOT** come on site if you or your child have symptoms. Thank you.

Parents are not allowed to enter the building with the children.

Clean Uniform - to be worn - we realise that some children may have outgrown an item or two. Bare below the elbow if possible. **No Reading Folders please.**

There will be:

Staggered times for school entry, playtime, lunch time and home time.

- Nursery and Reception - 9am and 2.30pm (Normal classroom doors)
- Y1 - 9.15 and 2.45pm - (Normal classroom doors)
- Y6 - 9.30 and 3pm (Hall door)
- Lockdown attendees 8.55am and 3pm - (Hall door).

Parents/pupils asked to social distance on the playground.

Please use the dining centre gate.

An additional cleaner in school all day for door handles, toilets, equipment etc.

Hand sanitiser, signage and PPE where needed.

Pupils and staff will wash their hands/use sanitiser:

- On entry to school
- After play
- Before lunch
- After lunch
- After a toilet trip/sneeze/cough!

'Bubbles' of up to 15 children with two adults who all stay together in one classroom, not mixing with others.

We will teach and encourage the children to socially distance as much as possible. I am sure that you will be aware that this will be very challenging, particularly with the younger age range of children. However, we have developed, and are continuing to develop, social distancing measures for all to follow. These are based on everyone maintaining 2m distance. We will do our best.

Unnecessary furniture has been removed from classrooms.

Well-being time every day to help with children's worries and settling back in to school.

Basic skills work in English, Maths and Topic to suit each year group/child.

3 sittings in the dining centre with social distancing for queuing, serving and sitting. All tables and seats cleaned between sittings.

No assemblies or collective use of the hall.

Disposable plastic bags instead of lunch boxes please.

BE AWARE:

Your child will be expected to behave well and follow these additional rules:

- follow any altered routines for arrival or departure
- follow school instructions on hygiene, such as hand washing and sanitising
- follow instructions on who pupils can socialise with at school
- move around the school as per specific instructions (for example, one-way systems, out of bounds areas, queuing)
- follow guidance about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoid touching your mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- tell an adult if you are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- follow rules about sharing any equipment or other items including drinking bottles
- follow rules about breaks or play times, including where children may or may not play
- follow rules about use of toilets
- don't cough or spit at or towards any other person
- follow rules for pupils at home about conduct in relation to remote education
- reasonable adjustments will be made for all SEND/vulnerable children including those with challenging behaviour
- parents are expected to reinforce these rules and guide their children at home.

Online learning and work packs will still be organised by staff for year groups/pupils who cannot yet attend.
