

# Prevent Strategy

It is the duty of all schools to promote British Values which include:

- universal human rights
- equality before the law
- democracy
- full participation in our society

Schools must respond to the ideological challenge of terrorism and the threat from those who promote it. In doing so, we must be clear: the ideology of extremism and terrorism is the problem; legitimate religious belief emphatically is not.

In school, we must teach tolerance of those that are different to us to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism. We must ensure that children and families are given appropriate advice and support if needed. We will tackle the challenge of inappropriate material and radicalisation on the internet.

Where school needs additional support, we will work with the LA and criminal justice system and access the successful

multi-agency 'Channel' programme, which identifies and provides support for people at risk of radicalisation if needed.

Our aim is to keep all our children and families safe and help them to be successful in a multi-cultural, multi-faith, multi-language society.
