### ***What is Child Protection about?***

At Westwood Park CP, all the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important. In our school, we respect our children and want to keep them safe and help to protect their rights.

We teach children to recognise risk in different situations and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

### ***How will we try to protect children?***

We give information and advice about staying safe online.

We think it is important that children know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something.

***(Everyone who works with pupils has had a full background check to make sure they are safe to work with children).***

You can talk to any adult in school.

It is Mrs Walker's special job to keep you safe – talk to them if you are worried.

KS2 pupils can use CPoms.

Tell a trusted friend and then go with them to speak to an adult.

***Don't keep it a secret if:***

Someone is bullying you;

Saying funny things to you that you do not like or upsets you;

Touching you;

Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol;

Hitting you or hurting you;

Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.
