make with anything and on anything! The more they explore, the more they will see themselves as writers. We create movements to music and practice our letter formation.

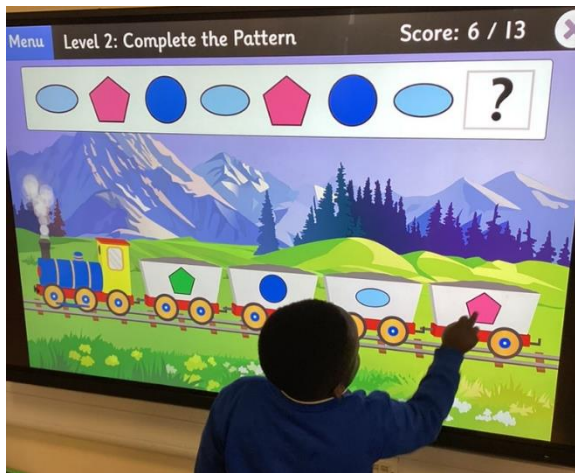


Over the year Reception will learn to write simple sentences. The children will be supported to write sentences using their phonic knowledge, finger spaces and full stops.



Mathematics

We embed Maths in very practical ways and we believe Maths should be happening in every provision area in our classroom. Mathematics helps children to make sense of the world around them through developing their ability to calculate, to reason and to solve problems. It enables children to understand and appreciate relationships and patterns in both number and space in their everyday lives.



Phonics

Phonics is a way of teaching children to read and write. We follow the 'Read Write Inc' scheme. Throughout the year children learn to say, read and write set 1 and 2 sounds and will be developing their skills in segmenting and oral blending e.g. c-a-t... cat.



Continuous provision

Continuous provision is a play-based approach to learning that offers children open-ended opportunities to learn and explore.
