Headteacher Messages

Ofsted: I am delighted to share with you our official Ofsted report. Our report card can be found online on the Ofsted website and the school website. We have one (already identified) area to work on, still lots to do here at the school but also, a lot to celebrate. I am incredibly proud of the children, staff, parents and Governors at this school!

Year 6: Our children in Year 6 took their SATs this week. Some of the papers were tough and others were long. Our children showed resilience, determination and bravery to overcome their worries. To say I am proud of them is an understatement! They are having a well-deserved trip to Inflatation on Friday and will be sporting their end of year hoodies from then on.

Holidays: Please note that school does not authorise any holidays taken in term time. It is school policy to send a fine to each parent of a child who misses more than 5 days of school due to a holiday taken in term time. We just want children here in school, in a good routine and learning. Multiple holidays taken within a three-year period increase the fine and also the chances of parents being called to court due to knowingly failing to secure good attendance at school.

PRIDE Morning: Please join us in class this Friday 22nd May 9-10am. Afterwards we are hosting our parent coffee morning- come and have a brew with Mrs Knipe and Mrs Lamb.
