Headteacher Messages

Ofsted: We have now had our Ofsted inspection this week. Thank you to all parents who contributed to the parent survey and who spoke to the inspectors. I have felt very proud of the staff and children at Westwood Park this week. Our children shone with their enthusiasm and resilience, our staff demonstrated unwavering dedication and professionalism, and our parents showed outstanding support throughout the process. I will let you know in due course what the outcome of the inspection was.

Fidgets: We know some children like to use fidgets and it helps them regulate BUT we need to reduce this. Can we ask that your child brings either NO fidgets in- we don't all need them- or they bring in one, small, quiet fidget. No toys allowed or anything with noise like the clicking ones. Thank you very much in advance for supporting this.

ADHD: A few weeks ago, staff had ADHD training. The training was run by Salford's Primary Inclusion Team- experts in the field! It was excellent and was useful to us here in school. I have attached a summary sheet for any families who have children with ADHD or who would like to know more about it.

Salford City Academy: Year 5s were visited this week by our local high school who brought a go-kart with them to show to our children. The theme was STEM- Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. The children had a great time!

Maths: Our Maths Hub specialist came into school today. She provided a demonstration lesson to all the teachers in the juniors. The focus was using manipulatives (equipment) in Maths. We are a school that is always growing and developing. I love this about us!

Breakfast Club: Our numbers are growing but we would still like more children to come. It opens from 8:15am but it doesn't close until 8:45 so you are welcome to pop into the hall on your way into school for your child to collect some food.
