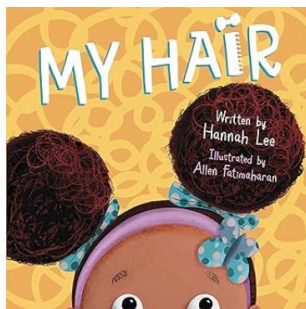
Some Requests...
